We purposefully seek to love others as God loves us so that believers might become more fully devoted to Christ and those who do not know Christ might hear His good news and follow Him.

A Church Grows Larger through KINGDOM WITNESSING.

GROWING PEOPLE - CHANGE Gospel Transformation (Acts 2:42):

God loves us just the way we are but loves us enough not to let us stay as we are. Through faith, God redeems and reconciles our heads (thoughts), hands (actions), and hearts (affections) to Him through His son Jesus Christ. We actively seek this personal and communal renewal through further devotion to God, authentic community, a lifestyle of worship, and a habit of service. As we grow in our faith our relationships are rejuvenated hearts purified, sins shunned, and the freedom of joy grows.

A Church Grows Deeper through DISCIPLESHIP.

SAVED PEOPLE - SERVE PEOPLE Lifestyle of Worship (Acts 2:43-45):

We are called to a lifestyle of prayer and worship; they do not simply occur during a church gathering. People transformed by the Gospel seek to respond to the Triune God with their whole lives in praise, adoration, and affection as they remember what God has done for them, submit their lives to Him, and obey His commands.

A Church Grows Strong through Their WORSHIP.

YOU CAN'T DO LIFE ALONE Authentic Community (Acts 2:46):

The church is not a building or place, but a collection of fully devoted followers of Christ united by the Holy Spirit. We are a community actively engaged with one another in encouragement, confession of sin, support, correction, and transformation. We are characterized by genuine love for one another, transparency in struggles, and purposeful in helping one another grow in our relationships with Christ.

A Church Grows Warmer through it's Fellowship with the COMMUNITY.

YOU CAN'T OUT-GIVE GOD *Grow Our Faith Walk (Acts 2:47):*

Generosity does not come at the risk of future poverty. on the contrary, generosity is the route to prevent future deprivation. If you give God your time, he multiplies it. If you give God your money, he multiplies it. If you give God your talent, he multiplies it. We need not fear that by helping others succeed at work we will compromise our own wellbeing. God has promised to give us all that we need.

A Church Grows Broader through the NEXT GENERATION.

Worship is related t every area of our lives. We are called to eat, drink, speak, think and work to the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:31). Worship cannot be narrowed down to a particular time and place as if God does not claim authority over certain aspects of our lives. There are no neutral desires or deeds; everything is an expression of worship.
